Momentary Modulation Kate Banazi


I spent a few months earlier this year slowly scanning through a box of precious photographs.

Beginning around the early 1930s they document my father's family—their lives, friendships and their migration from India to England.


I recognised ornaments and motifs, repetitions and rituals, buildings that I have visited, lived in and faces that are familiar but most now a memory.


This is my letter of love to her.


